Paint or draw a picture of the very hungry caterpillar.



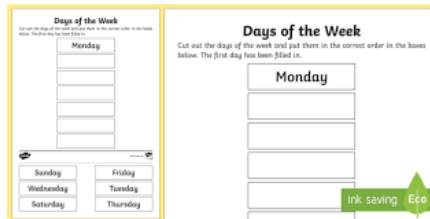
Make a list of the different foods that the caterpillar ate in the story.

Cut out the 7 days of the week and stick them in the right order.



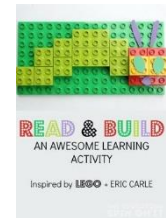
Write sentences to describe how the caterpillar was feeling at different parts of the story.



Make a painting of the very hungry caterpillar using hand prints.



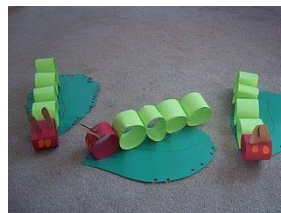
Can you make a model of the hungry caterpillar using Duplo bricks or lego?
